



Community Funding Application Guidelines

Vail-Summit Orthopaedics has been a part of community life in both Eagle and Summit counties for over two decades. We believe that community health encompasses not only the body, but the mind, and we endeavor to support opportunities that promote wellness and education.

If your organization is soliciting financial support from Vail-Summit Orthopaedics, the following guidelines will help you determine if your request is appropriate.

How we consider requests:

We require that every applicant for funding fill out our Community Funding application.

Applications are reviewed twice a year. **Applications are due by September 15th (for fall/winter) and April 15th (spring/summer).**

What we are looking for:

- Local programs or events
- Focus on healthy activities, community wide interest, and educational opportunities. (Examples: team sports, health fairs, outdoor youth programs, scholarship programs)
- Opportunities for challenge grants or matching gifts

What we do not support:

- Solicitations by third-party fundraisers
- Individual sponsorships
- National programs that have little impact on local projects
- Non-accredited educational organizations
- Organizations who do not have 501c3 (non-profit) status
- Politically sponsored or affiliated causes
